In-Class Activity:

Analyze a theme from Hurricane Katrina

Lets practice developing ideas by **brainstorming** and visualizing information by sketching **thumbnails**. For this project, you will use these techniques to develop an interactive graphic idea that explains one **theme** from Hurricane Katrina.

Your goal is to produce a **storyboard** for your graphic. Use the **process** we learned to focus on a theme. Consider the choices you have in your **bag of tricks** to tell the story and how you will use **navigation** to lead the reader through the information. Decide what visual elements you will use to illustrate the information.
